Upon completion, Master Gardeners are required to provide volunteer service hours and must participate in on-going training, which is available at both the state and county levels.

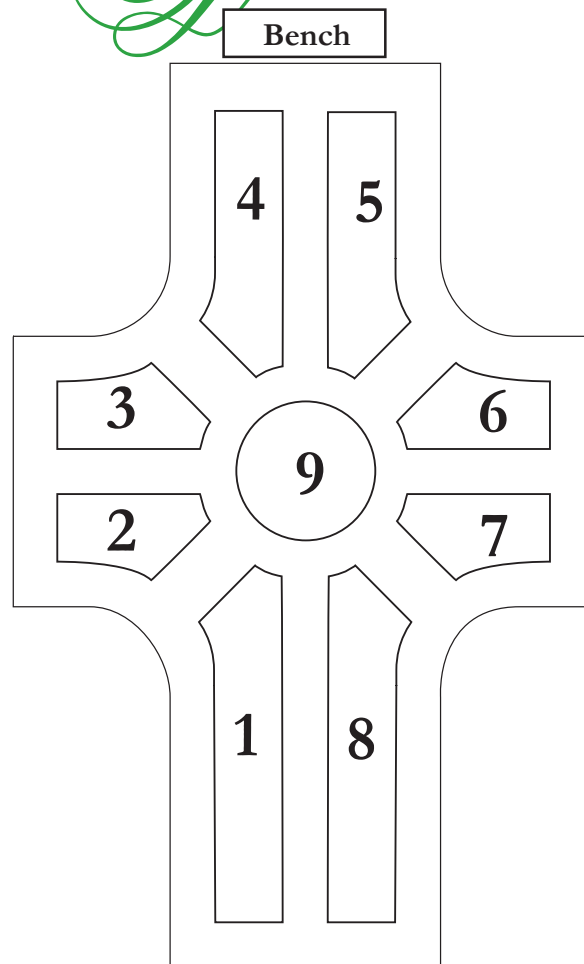
